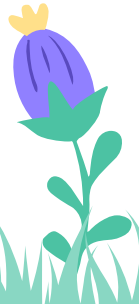

02

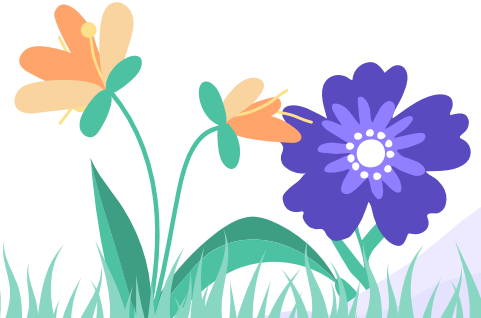
Podcast

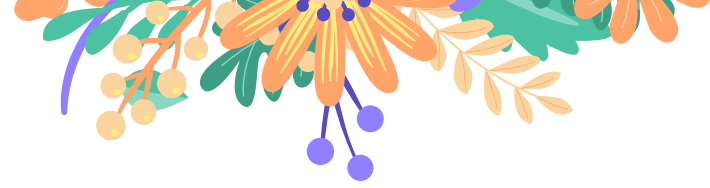


